TO MAKE A CLAIM

PLEASE BE AWARE THERE ARE STRICT TIME LIMITS

1. If serious, attend the Hospital immediately
2. Attend with your General Practitioner to report your injuries and obtain a MACA Medical Certificate
3. Report the accident to the Police Assistance Line (131 444) or to the local Police Station to obtain a COP5 event number within 28 days
4. Complete an Accident Notification Form and submit this to the CTP insurer within 28 days of the accident to obtain up to \$5,000 of treatment expenses and lost earnings
5. Complete a Personal Injury Claim Form and submit this to the CTP Insurer within 6 months of the accident to receive unlimited treatment and other losses such as loss of income, treatment expenses, pain and suffering and care received from family or others

Did you know: Even if you cannot identify the vehicle (hit and run) but the accident was not your fault, you may still be able to claim

immediately!

Note: If the driver refuses to exchange details, call the police

1. Take photos of the vehicles after impact before moving the car (if safe to do so) and a photograph of the accident scene
2. Write down the address of the accident
3. Obtain details of all drivers involved: name, contact number, address, licence number
4. MUST obtain the vehicle registration (for the vehicle, not the trailer) of all vehicles involved
5. Obtain name, address and contact phone number of any witnesses
6. Take note of the time of the crash, date, the weather and street lighting on the road
